Important tourist rich locations are identified with bigger black dot and icons. The larger the icons the more significant the attraction. Important locations where intercity fast trains typically stop eg TGV, Thalys, ES, AV, Eurostar etc which always require additional supplements and/or seat reservation and are indicated by orange lines. Private railways and seasonal routes are included with the little steam train icon. For example the seasonal Swedish Inlandsbanan and Scarborough Spa Express (England). Open all year are the Zillertalbahn private railway between Jenbach ↔ Mayrhofen (Austria) and the Jacobite steam train (Scotland) between Mallaig ↔ Fort William.

All high speed routes eg TGV, Thalys, AV, ES, InterCity (IC) and EuroCity (EC) are connected by orange lines and require mandatory supps/seat res. The Interrail App always indicates where supps and seat res are mandatory.

High-speed German ICE/IC and Austrian RJ/IC/EC Routes are indicated by purple lines are included in RailPass. Always check if seat is reserved which is indicated by the electronic display located above or side of the seat.

All other connections between major towns and cities, unless indicated above, are mainline. Always double check the Interrail App before boarding especially in Eastern Europe and Greece. NB: Polish TLK reservations are free.

Local regional lines ie RE/R/TER etc in every country are completely free to travel on. Regional trains usually take different, more interesting, routes than fast main line ones. Especially in Austria, Germany and Italy.

Many of the scenic routes are absolutely jaw dropping spectacular and are indicated by bright green highlight.

Privately run scenic routes typically in Austria (Jenbach ↔ Mayhofen) and dedicated trains/carriages in Switzerland eg (Glacier Express) do require additional tickets and are indicated by green highlighted line.

All S-Bahn (not U-Bahn) trains (Austria, Switzerland and Germany) are included in RailPass. Many Airports in Germany are connected to S-Bahn (NB. Green logo signs - blue on InfoRailMap). NB: Always remember to complete railpass travel diary.

Railway tunnels are present in most countries. EC/IC fast train services between Visp ↔ Spiez is through Gottard Base Tunnel and misses all the beautiful scenery!

Bus routes are indicated by thin pink lines. Swiss Travel Pass includes bus, boat and railway services.

Europe contains many stunning islands and ferry connections are abundant particularly in Scandinavia, UK, Ireland, Greece, Mediterranean Sea and for getting to and from North Africa. For many locations ferries (large, small, fast and slow) are the only way to get there without flying. Don't let having to arrange a ferry deter you from visiting Finland, Sardinia, Corsica, Malta or Greek islands for example. It is super easy to arrange online and ports are always easy to get to via public transport.

Due to the lack of space only a selection of popular ferry connections are included. Always check Interrail App for potential discounts as they change yearly and discounts also change seasonally. Many popular routes attract huge discounts so well worth checking out. www.link info is included within info boxes for the most popular routes which attract railpass discounts.

InfoRailMap 2020 icons clearly identify UNESCO sites, important monuments and protected landscapes, historically important Roman artefacts, religiously inspired buildings including cathedrals, mosques, monasteries, abbeys and interesting churches. Also significant and well worth stopping off to admire are the numerous castles, châteaux, forts, bridges and citadels. Unique to Europe are it's stunning old world medieval towns many of which are lovingly restored, preserved and kept in tip top shape (notably in Belgium, Italy, France, Czechia and Slovakia) and being continually cleaned, rebuilt and improved in Germany. New for 2020 is the Medieval icon which denotes locations where buildings have significant Romanesque and Gothic inspiration. For example buildings which have external sgraffito/fresco paintings and buildings from this era including Switzerland, Austria and Germany which display external artwork for instance Lindau (Germany) and Feldkirch and Innsbruck (Austria). This is you have limited time the bigger icons are the most impressive locations to visit. For example Toledo (south of Madrid) in Spain is a magnificent display of the most impressive of all the included icons.

InfoRailMap icons primarily indicate where to focus your attention if you want to speed tour the continent, however due to lack of space (with the exception of the detailed InfoRailMap for Switzerland/Austria/Northern Italy) only provide icon info on the major towns and is in no way a definitive schematic of every single delightful old world town to visit.

Predominately in England, Scotland, Ireland and France is the popular sport of horse racing which is denoted with a race horse and is well worth the effort particularly in Ireland as racecourses always have ample facilities to sample the local beer and Guinness.

Budget airlines (CODE) provide almost instant access to many top locations. Consider including budget airlines if you want to tour the whole continent with a global pass. Top destinations for working backwards into central Europe are Portugal, Norway and Greece.

The luggage store icon is only displayed in the Switzerland detailed InfoRailMap pages due to lack of space on the main InfoMap pages. Although the majority of major train stations offer some kind of coin operated luggage store.

Food and alcohol have important cultural significance and where you can expect to find outdoor cafe/restaurant/beer culture the Gastronomy icon is displayed.

The bigger the icon for the main tourist destination denotes the bigger and more attractive the location.

Europe has a diverse climate and relevant icons display geographical info. Detailed InfoRailMap pages covering Swiss, French, German and Italian Alps include the Mountain icon and is accompanied with the elevation height in meters in order to get an accurate idea of what to expect. Mont Blanc (4,810km) in France is the highest peak in Europe closely followed by Swiss Matterhorn (4,478km). Swiss Jungfrau (3,466km) affectionately called the "Top of Europe" is actually the most attractive of extended mountain ranges and thus has an enormous purpose built viewing platform so you can admire the full scale of this wondrous and extra special location. Each country has a slightly different take on how each look after their green space. The Hiking icon is included with many towns and cities and indicates that walking is the best option for discovering the location.

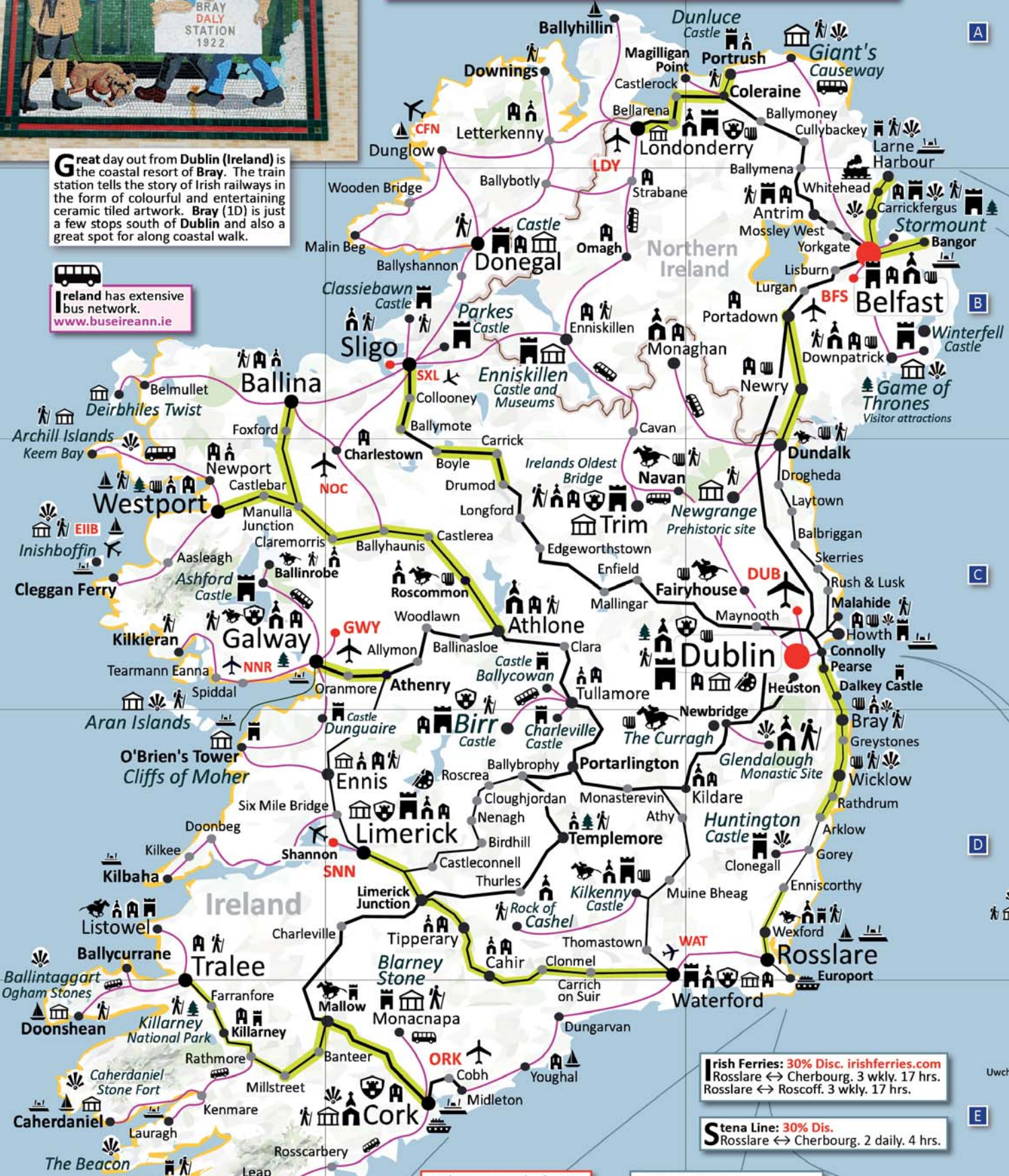

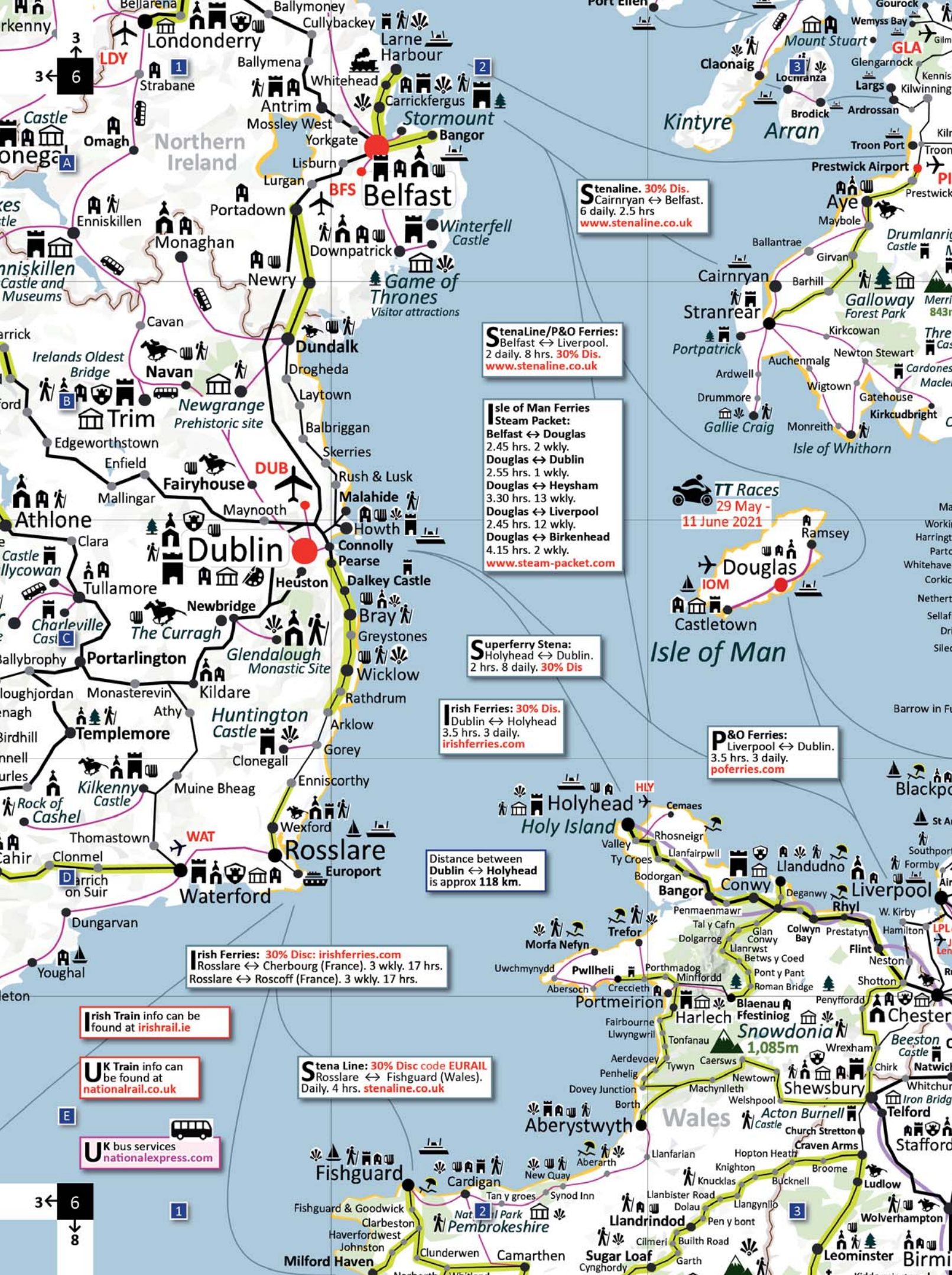

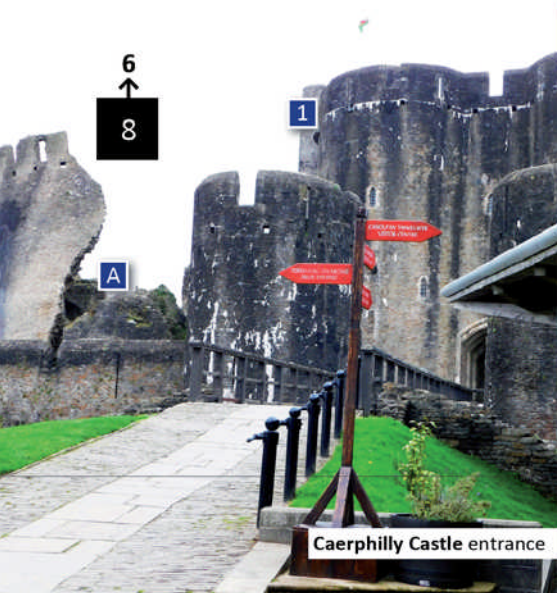

**C**ardiff (capital of Wales) is a perfect base to investigate this scenic and history rich location. Top of the list for days out are awesome castle town of **Caerphilly**, ancient roman town of **Swansea** which boasts a vast beach and the historic castle at **Pembroke** which will enchant your imagination. Wales is best visited in Spring time. Top scenic routes include **Cardiff ↔ Caerphilly**, **Rhymney** and **Merthyr Tydfil** which collectively are known as the famous Valleys. Round trip between **Cardiff ↔ Swansea** ↔ **Shrewsbury** ↔ **Hereford** visits ancient heritage cities and charming countryside.
